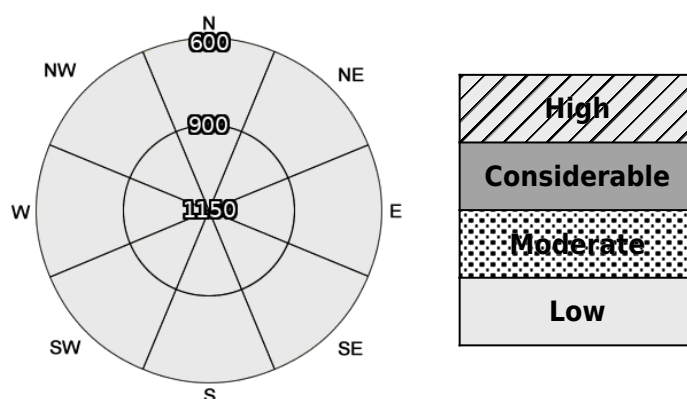


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The vast majority of the snow will be well bonded and stable. Isolated pockets of softer, less well bonded windslab will be present in steeper, wind sheltered locations on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Depth and distribution of these deposits will not be extensive. Snow cover will be very patchy below 900 metres with most cover being encountered on the highest mountains of the main Cairngorm Plateau. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Dry throughout with sunny conditions forecast. Strong South-Easterly winds easing overnight as they veer to become moderate South-South-Westerly. Freezing level gradually rising from 650 metres to reach 1200 metres by the end of the afternoon.
