

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/03/2022


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight, cool conditions will re-freeze the snowpack and it will remain generally well bonded and stable in all locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will maintain dry and settled conditions. The strong South-Easterly winds will ease becoming light to moderate and veering slightly to Southerly in the afternoon. The freezing level will fall to around 1100 metres in the early hours of the morning, then rise to above the summits during the day.

Comments

The snowpack surface layers will be firm and icy with serious consequences in the event of an uncontrolled slip.
