

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/03/2022


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised unstable windslab will persist, mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 1000 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable. Cornices exposed to the direct effects of the sun will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to strong South-South-Easterly winds will ease overnight and during the day be light and variable. Dry throughout the period, with the summit air temperature below freezing overnight and morning, rising above freezing during the afternoon.

Comments

The surface of the snowpack in shaded areas will remain hard, with serious run outs.
