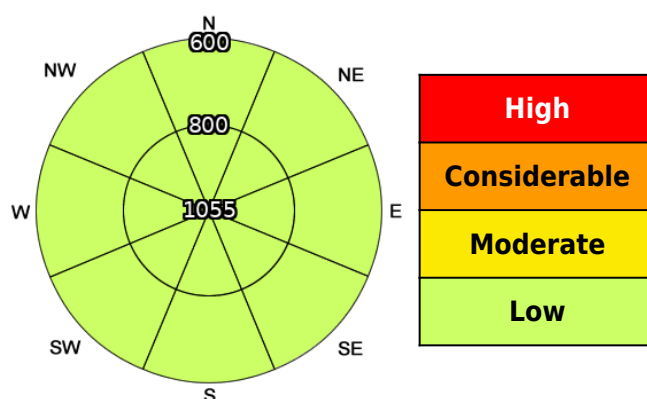


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 23/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable throughout with widespread surface softening through the day, especially on sunny aspects. Firmer snow on steep shaded North-West and North aspects at higher elevations. Patchy snow distribution generally and many hillsides will be bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Dry throughout with good sunny spells. It will remain mild with the freezing level staying well above the highest summits. Moderate to fresh South-East winds will gradually veer South-West by the end of the forecast period.

Comments

High pressure firmly in charge. Becoming more cloudy and slightly less mild towards the end of the week.
