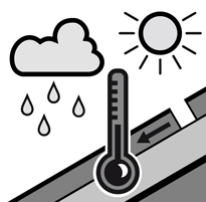
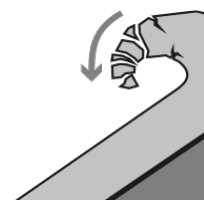
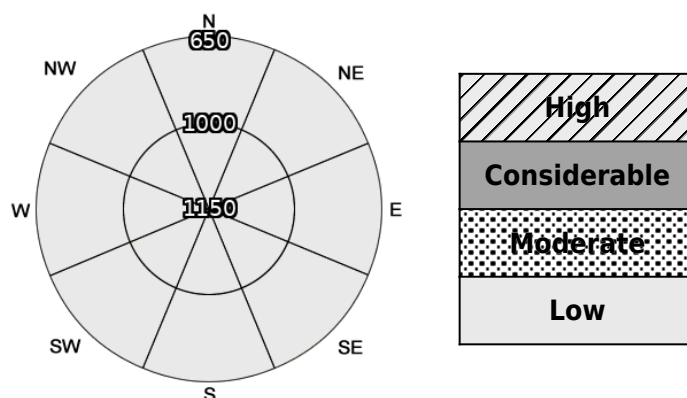

Little change is expected to the snowpack. Overnight, the snowpack will partially consolidate. During the day it will become moist and soft in all locations but should remain generally well bonded and stable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will remain well above the summits throughout the period. The fresh Southerly winds will veer and ease becoming West-South-Westerly. Cloudier than of late but should be mainly dry with the possibility of some drizzle or light rain in the morning.
