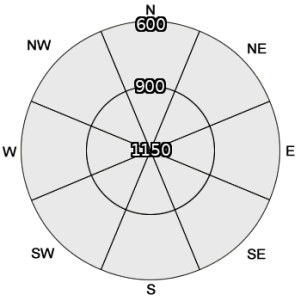


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Wed 23/03/2022 TO 18:00HRS Thu 24/03/2022



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

A dry and bright day with the freezing level above the highest summits. Isolated and light rain showers are expected in the afternoon. Winds will be fresh Southerlies veering to Westerly during the day.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain soft and thawing at all levels. It will be generally well bonded. Cornice collapse and falling ice will remain a potential hazard. Greatest snow accumulations will be on high plateau areas and in North to East facing corries above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Wed 23/03/2022

Observed Weather Influences

A dry and bright day with the freezing level above the highest summits. Light Southerly winds.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack is generally well bonded and stable on all aspects. Isolated, wet snow surface instabilities were present on steep sun exposed slopes. Greatest snow accumulations are on high plateau areas and in North to East facing corries above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard is Low.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions	Diminishing snowpack, good above 950 metres. Good visibility, despite the hazy conditions. Winds approx 10 - 20 mph fresh, cooling etc
Comments	Another dry and bright day expected tomorrow with some isolated and light rain showers possible in the afternoon.
