

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 28/03/2022**


**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected in the snowpack. The greatest deposits of snow tend to be on North to East aspects above 900 metres. It will firm up slightly overnight, and then soften through the day. Stability will be good throughout; however, some unstable sections of cornice will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a clear night another dry day with sunny spells is expected. The freezing level will be above the summits. Winds will be light and variable.
