

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 29/03/2022


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Greatest deposits of snow will exist in the higher Northerly and Easterly corries and gullies. The snowpack will be generally stable throughout with a firm surface possible in shaded recesses and gullies, mainly above 1000 metres. Remaining cornices will be suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with light to moderate variable Northerly winds. The freezing level will lower to around 1100 metres by the end of the day.

Comments

Snow surface may remain firm and icy in shaded locations at higher levels.
