
#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The majority of the older snow will refreeze, remaining stable and becoming icy in some locations. New unstable areas of wind slab will develop over older snow-ice in wind sheltered locations on South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. These accumulations will be shallow and are not expected to be widespread. Elsewhere, cover will be best on high North to East facing corries. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

A much colder day with the freezing level sub 600 metres for most of the period. Light snow showers will fall on strong North to North-East winds.

#### Comments

A return to more Wintry conditions. Old snow will become icy again in some locations.
