### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 31/03/2022


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised, fresh deposits of moderately bonded windslab are expected to accumulate on mostly South-East to South-West aspects above 1000 metres. Areas affected will be where accumulations achieve depth, especially in wind sheltered locations such as depressions, corrie headwalls and gully lines. Elsewhere the remaining snowpack will remain hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate strength Northerly winds. Light snow showers are expected throughout the forecast period. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.

#### Comments

The remaining snowpack remains very hard and icy as the Northerly airstream continues to bring very cold temperatures at summit level. The consequences of a slip/trip are serious as many of the old snow patches run out into boulders.
