



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 02/04/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change expected in the continuing cold conditions. The old snowpack will remain frozen, firm and well bonded on all aspects and altitudes. Some accumulations of the new snow will exist in sheltered locations above 900 metres, these will be shallow and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The winds will be light and variable, mainly from the Northern sector. Showers bringing only trace amounts of new snow will diminish by midnight with no further precipitation expected. The freezing level will drop towards the glens around dawn before slowly rising to 900 metres by the early evening.

Comments

The old snowpack remains frozen and hard with serious, abrupt runouts.
