

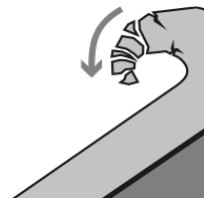

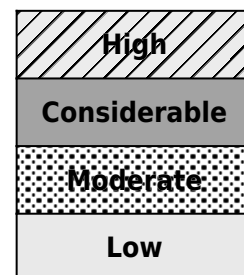
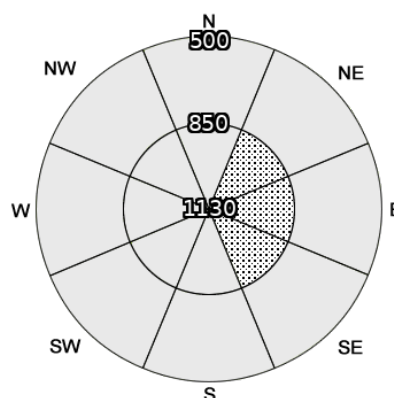
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will continue to develop, primarily on East to South-Easterly aspects, above 850 metres. Some cross-loading on gully flanks will also occur on North-Easterly aspects; these in the most sheltered locations of steep gully exits and coire headwalls. Some new cornice development will occur above slopes of these indicated aspects. The older areas of mature snow elsewhere will be frozen, well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler temperatures and further snow showers will persist over the period. The Freezing Level will lower overnight to below 400 metres, rising only slightly from first light. The winds, initially light East-North-Easterly will increase to strong Northerly, easing North-North-West during the day.
