

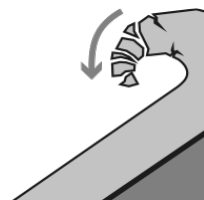

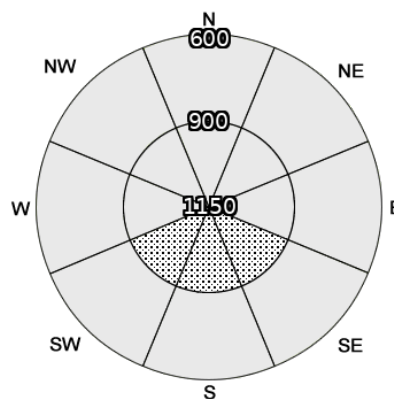
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of moderately bonded windslab will persist in wind sheltered locations mainly on South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Stability will be poorest on scarp slopes, gully tops and on steep convex features. Elsewhere deep drifts will be encountered in lee locations above 600 metres with older snow very firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers at all levels, mainly overnight and later in the afternoon. Strong to near gale force winds from the North-North-West throughout.

Comments

A challenging day in full Winter conditions. Friday is not expected to be quite as wild on the hills but will still be more Winter than Spring.
