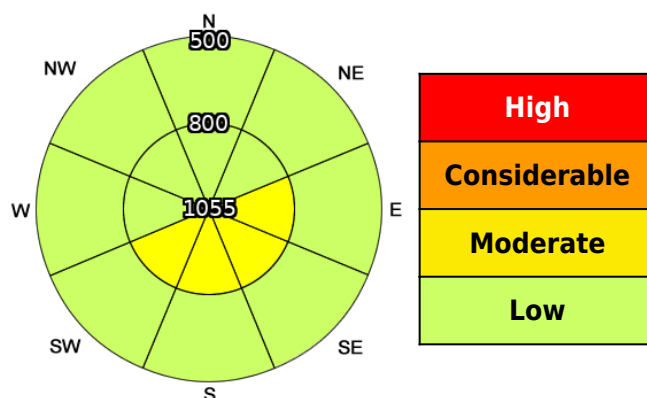


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 09/04/2022****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in wind-sheltered areas. Greatest accumulations will be on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will continue to build above these aspects. The old, now covered, snowpack will be refrozen and very hard. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Winds will be mainly North-Westerly. Showers are expected throughout the period, falling as snow above 200 metres overnight and above 400-500 metres during the day.

Comments

The surface of the old snowpack, which is now generally covered with new snow, is refrozen and hard.
