

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 10/04/2022


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

With only light snow showers expected general snowpack stability will be good in most areas. Localised areas of windslab will remain in summit gully exits and around corrie rims but these areas are not expected to be deep or extensive and should in the main be avoidable. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a few light snow showers overnight then dry and settled conditions for Sunday, winds will be light generally South-Westerly, the freezing level will initially be around 800 metres rising to 1000 metres by the end of the day.

Comments

Some exposed slopes will remain firm and icy and will require caution. Cornices will be prone to collapse.
