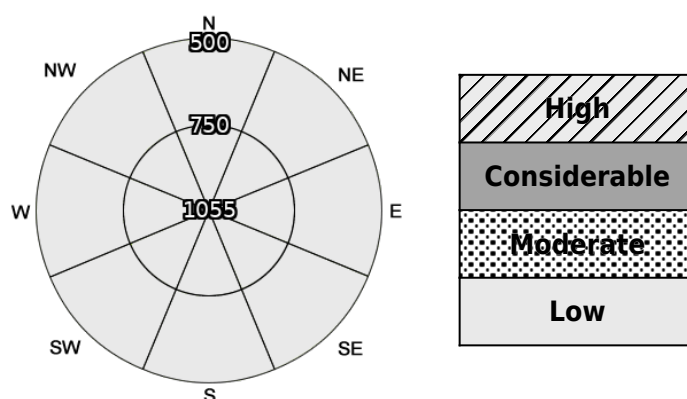


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 11/04/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

A covering of soft but stable snow will be present on all aspects above 500 metres. There will be a gradual thaw through the day. The older patchy snow will remain very firm, well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry cloudy day. East-South-Easterly winds will increase from light to become strong by the end of the day. The freezing level will be just above the summits.

Comments

Despite the milder temperatures, it will remain and feel very wintry on the hills. Icy in places on exposed summit slopes.
