





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will initially remain mainly on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. As the winds increase new unstable windslab will form in wind sheltered locations mainly on West to North aspects above 900 metres. Greatest accumulations will be on steep slopes, gully tops and coire rims. Other localised aspects will also be affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain generally dry through the forecast period before some light snowfall later in the afternoon. Overnight and during the day steadily strengthening South-Easterly winds are expected to reach gale force during the afternoon. Overnight the freezing level will be around 900 metres, although rising through the day, it will remain cool.

Comments

A significant change through the period as the increasing South-East winds redeposit snow. Remaining cool and wintry.
