





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As thaw conditions become established, surface instabilities will develop wherever there is soft snow overlying older snow-ice on steep terrain. Most aspects will be affected above 900 metres. Currently greatest depths of snow are on East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Initially cold overnight but by dawn the freezing level will be above the summits. Snow showers turning to light rain at all levels. Winds will be strong South-East overnight, easing during the day, East-South-East then East.

##### Comments

A significant thaw is forecast.
