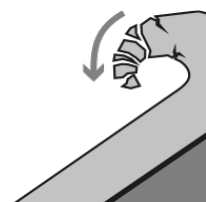
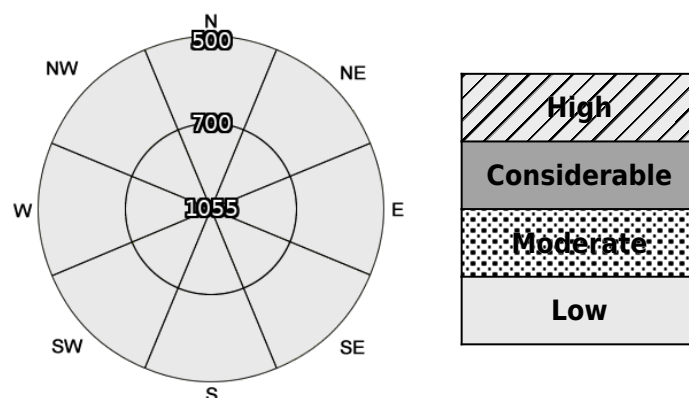


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 13/04/2022****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The remaining snow cover will continue to thaw and diminish. Snowpack stability will be generally good. Minor wet snow surface instabilities possible on steep slopes exposed to the sun. The few remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Greatest cover on North through East to South aspects above 700 metres. Cover becoming very patchy at lower elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry cloudy day. Light winds will be mainly North-Westerly. The freezing level will be above the summits.
