





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate but remain well bonded. Snow cover will diminish on all aspects with greatest cover remaining in North to East facing corries and on the highest plateau areas. Collapsing cornices, falling rocks and ice will be a significant hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining mild with the freezing level over the summits in this area. Rain overnight but dry during the day. Note that the summits of the highest main Cairngorm summits will see light snow showers. A strengthening strong breeze from the North-West throughout the day.

Comments

Thaw conditions continue, collapsing ice and falling rocks will be a significant hazard around steep terrain.
