

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 14/04/2022


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Mild conditions overnight and tomorrow will maintain a soft and moist snowpack. General snowpack stability will be good in most areas. Localised surface instabilities may exist in summit gully exits and around corrie rims but these areas are not expected to be deep or extensive and should in the main be avoidable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mild and mainly dry with moderate to fresh Southerly winds. The freezing level will be well above the summits.

Comments

Mild conditions will maintain a slow thaw at all levels. The snowpack will be soft and moist in most areas. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Rockfall will remain a possibility. Rockfall noted today.
