





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The diminishing snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate, remaining generally well bonded. Some minor surface instabilities will be present on steeper slopes, especially around gully tops and coire rims. The greatest cover remaining on North-East through East to South facing aspects and on the highest plateau areas. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be moderate, initially from the North-West backing during the day to Southerly by the afternoon. The freezing level will be above the summits with no significant precipitation expected.

Comments

Mild temperatures and thaw conditions continuing. Collapsing ice and falling rocks will be a significant hazard around steep terrain.
