



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 15/04/2022**



Wet Snow




Cornices

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Mild conditions overnight and tomorrow will maintain a soft and moist snowpack. The snowpack stability will remain generally good in most locations. Localised, surface instabilities may exist in steep summit gully exits and around steep corrie rims but these areas are not expected to be extensive and should in the main be avoidable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will be well above the summits through the period. Remaining mild but dry with fresh South-South-Easterly winds.

**Comments**

Mild conditions will maintain a slow thaw at all levels. The snowpack will be soft and moist in most areas. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Rockfall will remain a possibility.
