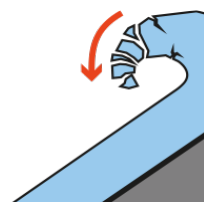
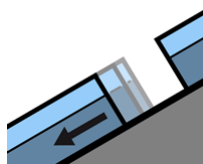
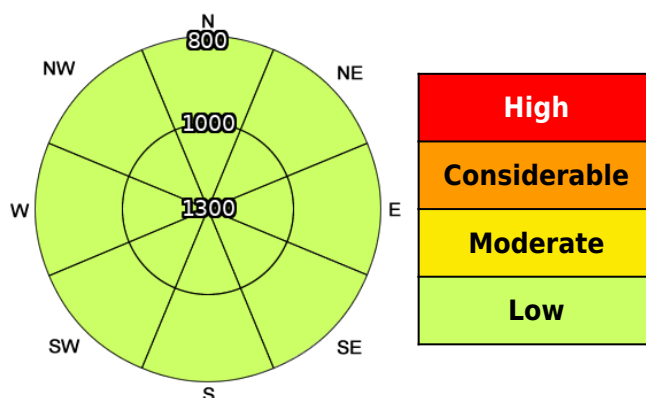

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels, and remain well bonded and stable throughout. There will be the potential for some wet snow surface instabilities especially around steep coire back walls. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Mild, dry conditions will continue with moderate to strong Southerly winds. The freezing level will remain well above the summits.

Comments

Rock and icefall will continue to be a hazard during the thaw conditions.
