

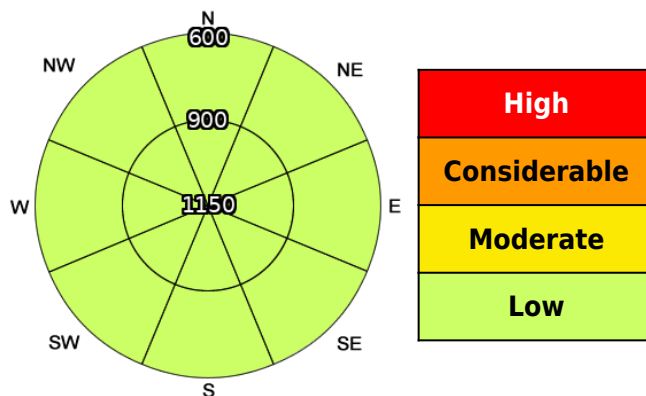
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 18/04/2022

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The rate of thaw will slow as the freezing level lowers, giving well bonded and stable snow throughout. Largest areas will be encountered on the high plateau areas and above 900 metres in steep North to East facing corries. Very little snow will be found below 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain or drizzle overnight, ceasing by mid-morning. Strong South-Easterly winds gradually easing overnight, but then increasing as they veer to become strong South-Westerly during the afternoon. The freezing level will gradually lower to around 1200 metres by late morning.

#### Comments

This is the last report for the 21/22 season.
