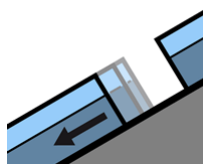

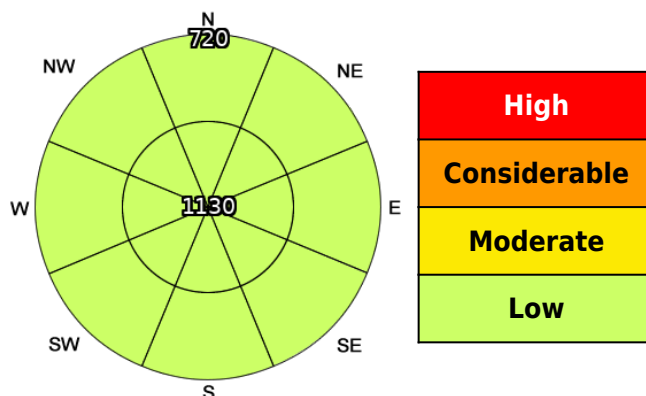

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in all locations. The patchy snowpack will become wet or moist but remain well bonded. Wet and weak residual cornices over selected East aspects. Thin, humid windslab is possible later on steep North to East aspects above 1000m but amounts expected to be negligible. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional showers of rain overnight, with a little snow over summits during daylight hours. Moderate South-West winds strengthening a little later. Much cooler by morning when the freezing level will be around 1000m.
