
**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited, through redistribution, in wind-sheltered areas, mainly on South to West aspects above 900 metres. Accumulations gaining depth are not expected to be extensive. The limited old snow deposits lying mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres will remain icy, very hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain cold, with the freezing level rising to around 500 metres during the day. It is expected to be mainly dry, with some light showers falling as snow at most levels during the early morning. Winds are expected to be generally North-Easterly, light at first then increasing to moderate overnight.

**Comments**

Patches of water ice are present on paths and hillsides.
