
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deposits of unstable windslab will be present in wind-sheltered areas, mainly on South to West aspects above 900 metres. Accumulations gaining depth are not expected to be extensive. The limited old snowpack, lying mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres, will remain icy, very hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will initially be strong East-North-Easterly, then North-Easterly and steadily decrease in strength overnight and during the morning to moderate, and light during the afternoon. It will be dry and cold, with the freezing level around 300 metres.

Comments

Patches of water ice present on hillsides and paths.
