
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. Deposits of unstable windslab will be present, mainly on South to West aspects above 900 metres. These will generally be shallow and not extensive. The limited old snowpack, lying mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres, will be icy, very hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and cold, freezing at most levels. Winds will be light generally South-Easterly.

Comments

Patches of water ice are present on paths and hillsides.
