

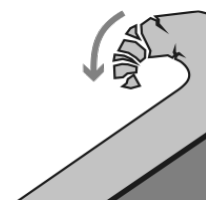

##### Avalanche Problems



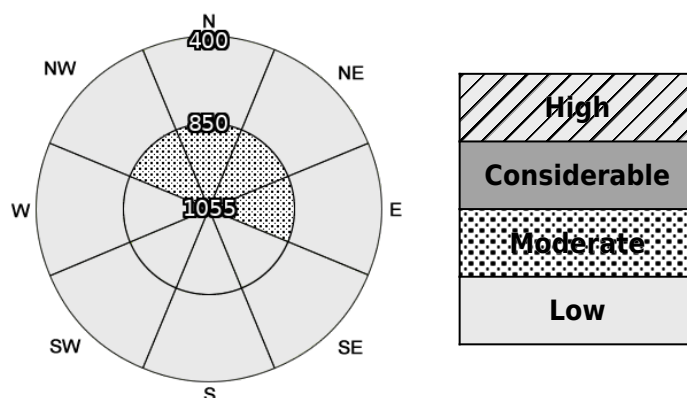
Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some depletion of the snow at lower elevations during the day with fresh unstable windslab accumulations developing on North-West to East aspects above 850 metres. Mostly affecting steeper terrain; wind sheltered ridge crests and the tops of gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be moderate South-West this evening, strengthening to fresh East-South-East overnight becoming moderate strength Southerly later. There will be moderate scattered snow showers. The freezing level will gradually rise from around 200 meters tonight to 450 meters later.

##### Comments

Deep snow cover on all aspects with many roller balls observed on Southerly aspects today. Some cornices have developed.
