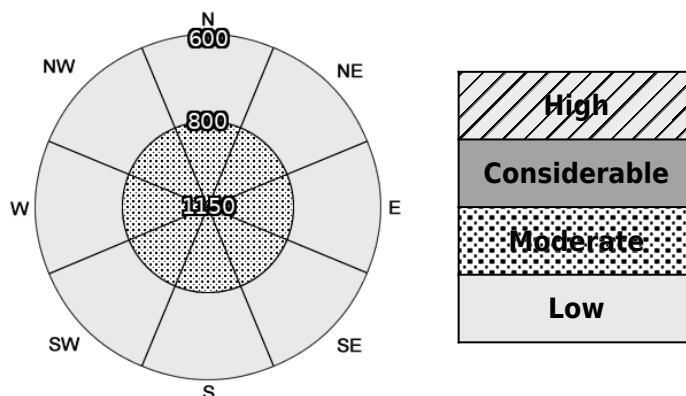
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution of existing snow will lead to soft fresh windslab developing in sheltered locations on mainly North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Wind sheltered steep terrain such as gully exits and scarp slopes will be particularly affected. Isolated pockets of windslab will also persist on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level is expected to remain below 600 metres with light snowfall at times, otherwise dry. Winds will strengthen throughout from the South-West.
