



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some redistribution of the snowpack in the strong winds. Areas of wind slab will be found in wind sheltered places on mainly North-West to North-East facing aspects above 800 metres with the tops of slopes and gullies being most affected. These areas will not be extensive, but will be poorly bonded. Fresh cornices, although not large, will be prone to collapse. Windward aspects will be generally scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry overnight and through the morning with a band of snow reaching the area during the afternoon. Strong winds will be from the South-East. The freezing level will be around 700 metres.
