






Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will initially be present in wind sheltered locations mainly on West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres. There will be a period of reduced stability overnight and into the morning as the temperature rises and rain arrives when avalanches are likely. The snowpack will then start to slowly consolidate through the day. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise above the summits in the evening and remain there through the period. Mainly dry in the evening followed by rain to summit level. Strong South-East winds veering to become Southerly during the day.

Comments

After mild conditions on Monday temperatures are forecast to drop again on Tuesday.
