





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Severe thaw conditions will destabilise recent deposits. Areas most affected will include steeper, wind sheltered locations on South-East, South, North-West and North aspects above 800 metres. Deepest accumulations will be encountered on the mountains situated along the Northern boundary of the forecast area. The small wind features present will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Evening snowfall will rapidly turn to rain as the freezing level rises to around 2250 metres overnight. Rain and significant thaw conditions will continue throughout the day. Moderate South-East veering Southerly winds.

Comments

Consideration required as to what is above as well as underfoot tomorrow. Rapid destabilisation expected.
