

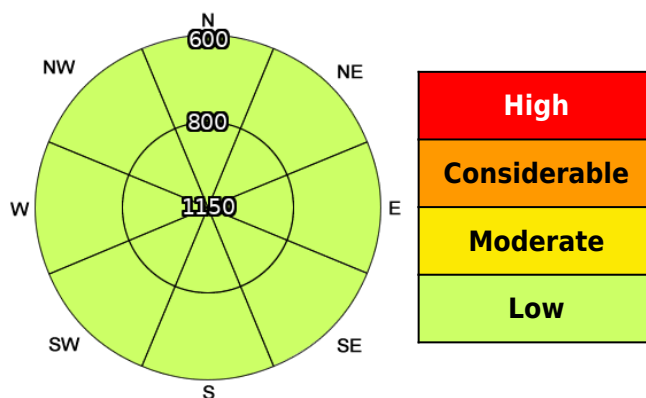

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Remaining snow will initially be wet and soft but generally well bonded in all locations. As the freezing level drops existing snow will become firmer, particularly at higher levels. Any new snowfall is expected to be very light and inconsequential. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will begin to drop, initially to around 1000 metres, then down to 650 metres during the afternoon. There will be light new snowfall during the morning. Strong winds will be from the South-South-West throughout the day.

Comments

A poor day on the hill with little visibility today, tomorrow will become cooler, snow becoming firmer at higher levels.
