


Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will accumulate in wind sheltered locations on North to East aspects above 800 metres. These areas will not be extensive with gully tops and corrie rims being most affected. Cornices will begin to build during the day. The existing snowpack will be stable and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry evening, snow will initially fall above 800 metres from the early hours before being confined to the highest summits from midday. Very strong South-Westerly winds will gradually ease. The freezing level will rise from 800 to 1100 metres.

Comments

Fresh snow will be mainly lying on bare ground.
