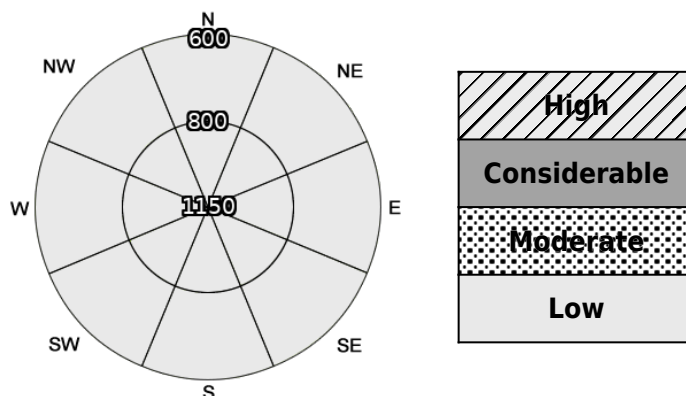
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The majority of the patchy snow cover will be well bonded and stable. Isolated accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will develop in a few steeper, wind sheltered locations on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Superficial cover at lower elevations will start to thaw. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level is expected to be around 700 metres overnight but rising to around the highest summits by late afternoon. Precipitation will initially fall as snow but will mostly turn to rain as the day progresses. Very strong winds throughout, South-South-West veering to become South-West in the afternoon.

Comments

Cooler overnight but becoming milder during Wednesday.
