

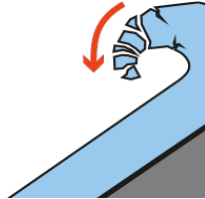

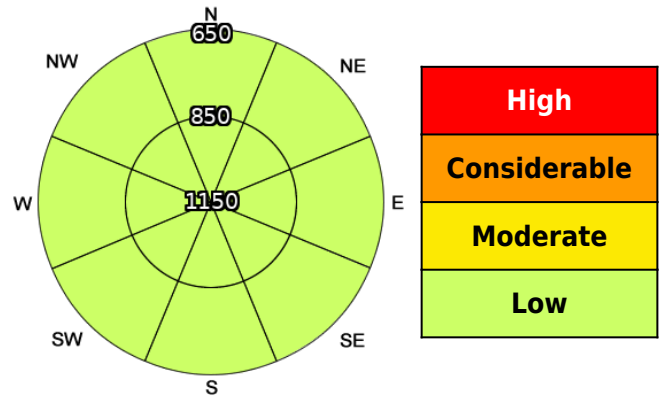
Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Shallow deposits of localised windslab will be present in wind sheltered locations mainly on North to Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Areas mostly affected are steep convex slopes, gully exits and coire rims. Exposed old snow deposits will remain firm and stable. Elsewhere there will be a light dusting of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing will remain above 1000 metres. Mostly dry through the forecast period, just an odd overnight shower risk. The South-Westerly winds will ease by dawn and then back becoming light East-North-Easterly.

**Comments**

Mostly dry conditions for the daylight hours on Thursday and Friday.
