


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 25/12/2022**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh snow deposits are expected above 1100 metres particularly on North to East aspects. However, these are not expected to be deep or extensive and should be relatively well bonded. At lower levels the snowpack will remain wet and stable. During the afternoon fresh deposits will be found at lower elevations, but will be shallow and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight and through the morning showers will fall as snow above 1100 metres. During the afternoon, these showers will fall as snow to progressively lower levels as the freezing level lowers. Strong winds from the South will veer, becoming Westerly.

**Comments**

A mild start to Christmas, but Santa hopefully delivering some colder weather in the afternoon.
