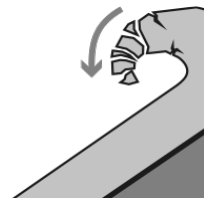
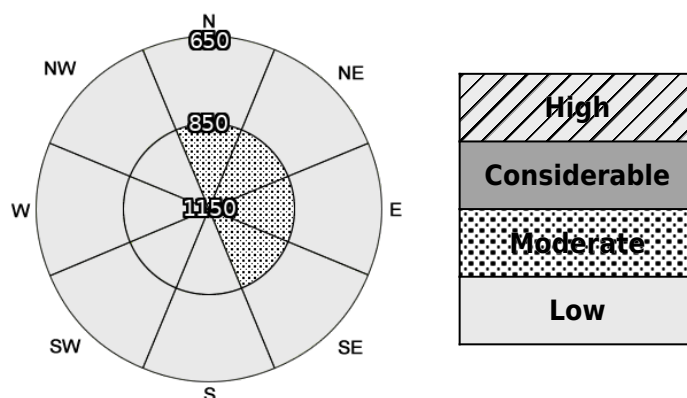


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 26/12/2022****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh unstable windslab will develop throughout the forecast period, mainly affecting North through East to South East aspects above 850 metres. Wind sheltered locations such as coire rims and gullies will be most affected. Fragile cornices will begin to form above these aspects. Slopes exposed to wind will be well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Showers throughout the forecast period will be snow above 300 metres. Winds will be strong West-South-Westerly. The freezing level will be around 300 metres.
