

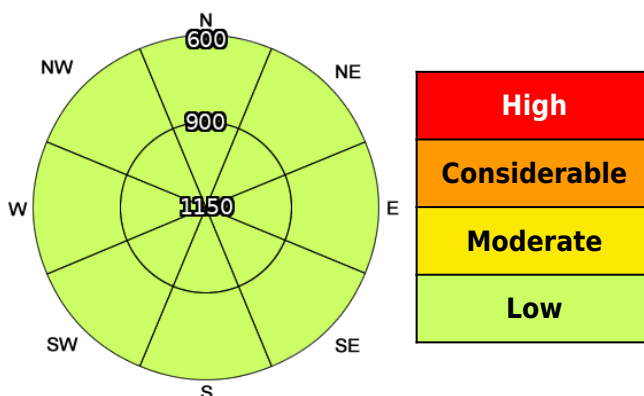

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 26/12/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface layers of the snow will gradually firm up as the freezing level lowers. All recent deposits will be well bonded and stable. Patchy cover at lower altitudes with some deeper accumulations in wind sheltered locations, mainly but not exclusively, on South-West through West to North aspects above 1000 metres. Shallow and insignificant fresh accumulations will form on North-East to South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A mostly dry night followed by some light snow at most levels from late morning. Winds during the day will be generally moderate Westerlies. The freezing level will fluctuate around 400 metres.

Comments

Wet surface layers of the snow likely to become firm and icy as the freezing level lowers to around 400m.
