




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the day fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in wind sheltered areas, mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Weaknesses will persist in the recently deposited windslab that lies mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. Elsewhere the old snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be light mainly North-Westerly during the first part of the night, then backing South-Westerly and increasing light to moderate. The freezing level will be around 500 metres. It is expected to be dry.
