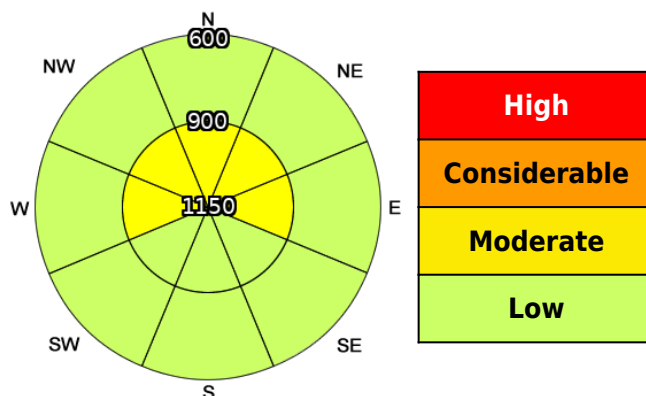
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The majority of snow will be stable and generally well bonded. Localised accumulations of moderately bonded snow will persist on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres, and also less frequently on some West and East aspects. Deepest accumulations will be encountered in wind sheltered locations such as gully tops and around steep corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation has been forecasted. Winds will be light, variable North-Westerly backing Westerly. The freezing level will lower to around 350 metres overnight, rising to 550 metres during the day.
