



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will consolidate at all levels. During Wednesday the snowpack will gradually refreeze above 1000m. No significant new snow is expected. Snowpack stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain showers will continue at all levels before clearing overnight. By Wednesday morning the freezing level will drop to around 1000m and it will be dry. Moderate Westerly winds.
