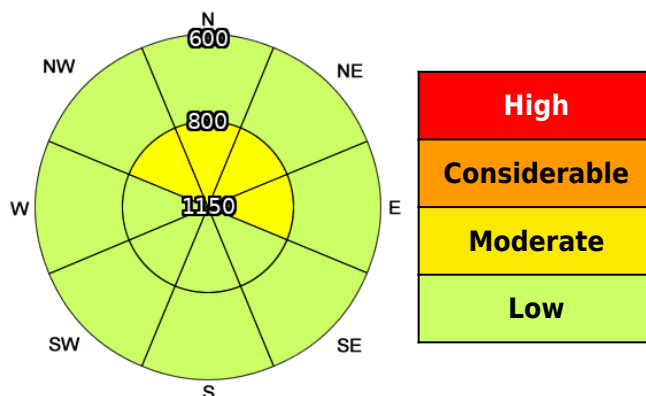
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised new accumulations will develop on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Deepest accumulations will be found around wind sheltered corrie rims and gully tops where deposits will only be moderately well bonded. Elsewhere the snow will be firm and remain well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be slightly cooler with the freezing level around 900 metres. There will be light snowfall, mostly overnight. Strong winds throughout, variable South-Westerlies.

Comments

Likely to be a poor day on the hill on Friday. Old snow becoming much firmer, particularly at higher levels.
