

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 07/01/2023


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will initially be wet and soft but will remain well bonded and stable. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Above 900 metres the snow cover will start to slowly refreeze. Any new snow will be inconsequential. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain at all levels overnight with only a dusting of snow around the highest summits as freezing levels drop to around 900 metres during the day. Gale force winds throughout, South-South-East or South during the day.

Comments

The snowpack is expected to refreeze throughout the day becoming firm and icy, particularly around the summits.
