

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of wet snow instability is expected overnight with steep slopes and gullies with a North to East aspects above 900 metres being most affected. Cornices will be prone to collapse. Stability will improve during the day as the snowpack consolidates in the colder conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be mild with the freezing level well above the summits and precipitation falling as rain at all levels. During the day the freezing level will be around 900 metres. Winds will be from the South.

Comments

Snowpack could become very hard and icy at higher levels in the colder conditions.
