




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Through the period areas of unstable windslab will develop on wind-sheltered North-West through North to East slopes and gullies above 900 metres. These areas will become deeper and more extensive through the day. Cornice collapse and avalanches are likely. Exposed windward aspect will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy showers throughout the period will fall as snow above 600 metres. Gale force winds will be from the South or South-West. The freezing level will be about 700 metres.
