

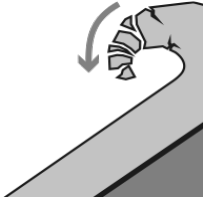

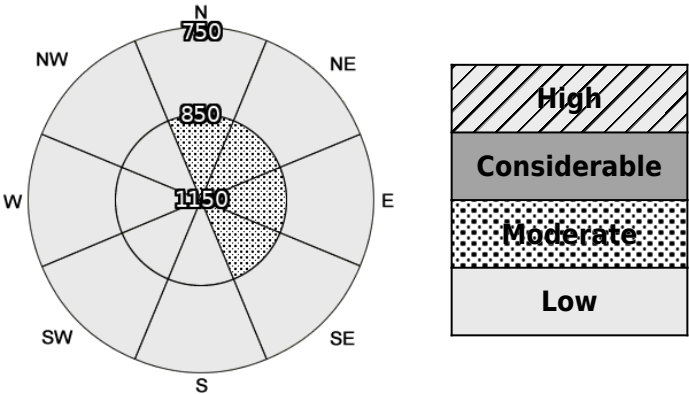
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of fresh unstable windslab will develop, mainly affecting North through East to South-East aspect above 850 metres. Steep wind sheltered locations such as gullies and coire rims will be most affected. Fragile cornices will form above these aspects. Elsewhere the old snowpack will be well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Showers throughout the forecast period will fall as snow above around 800 metres. Moderate South-West winds will veer Westerly during the afternoon. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.

Comments

A warmer spell on Tuesday afternoon then colder conditions will return.
