

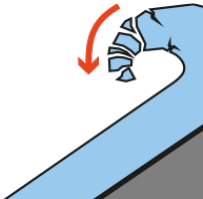

Avalanche Problems



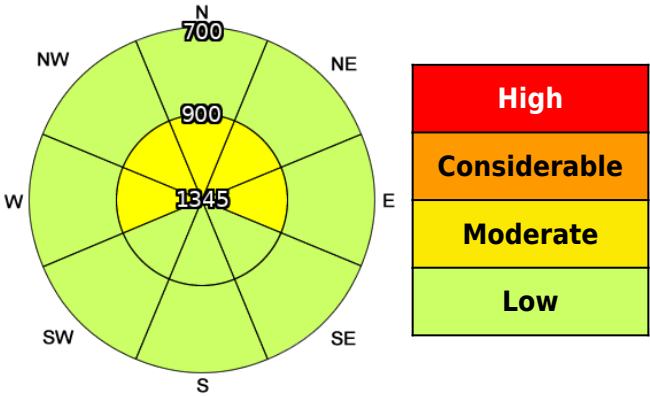
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to develop. Greatest accumulations will be on West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Fragile cornices will form above these aspects. The older snowpack will remain generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Showers throughout the period falling as snow above around 600 metres. Fresh to strong winds, Southerly initially, slowly veering to become Westerly in the afternoon. The freezing level will vary between 600 and 900 metres.

Comments

Graupel on the surface on Sunday will form a weak layer when covered in windslab.
